WARNING STATEMENT

TO PARTICIPANTS, TEAMS AND SPECTATORS

Although participation in supervised athletics and activities is generally considered safe, and serious injuries are not common, it is impossible to eliminate every risk. To help reduce accidents and injuries, players MUST obey safety rules, report all physical problems to their coaches, follow a proper conditioning program and inspect their own equipment. By registering for this program, you acknowledge that you have read and understand this warning. Those who do not wish to accept the risk should not register or participate.

INSURANCE/INJURIES

The City of Colorado Springs carries no insurance for players, spectators or game officials. The Emergency Medical Service will be called for all medical emergencies. Individuals are responsible for all charges resulting from a medical emergency. Teams are responsible for any first-aid equipment at game sites. Teams are encouraged to keep a list of insurance numbers for team members in case of an emergency.

SCHEDULES AND ROSTERS

All team schedules will be accessible at www.coloradosprings.gov/Adult-Sports prior to the start of the season.

At registration, adult teams ARE REQUIRED to submit a team roster with all players' names and phone numbers (no signatures required). Teams registering and paying via online MUST submit a team roster at the conclusion of registration. Team roster forms are available online and can be faxed to (719) 385-6013. Teams that do not submit a team roster will be penalized.

MAKE-UP/WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

Cancellation information is available by calling (719) 385-5981; select 6. If the recording is not updated, assume games are on. **AND/OR** Facebook @ Colorado-Springs-Sports or Twitter.com/CSSportsOffice

NOTE: Reschedules will be posted on the internet within 48 hours following the cancellation. Make-up/re-scheduled games will be added to the end of the schedule.

Team Information

FOR ALL SPORT LEAGUES

PR&CS does not accept scheduling requests. All games for all teams for all sports are scheduled during designated time frames.

The number of teams per league will determine season length.

At all recreation leagues, there are sub-levels of competition. These sub-levels further separate teams within each level of competition. The proper classification of your team is very important for the balance of the leagues. If PR&CS feels your team is in the wrong league, you may be subject to reclassification or other penalties.

PR&CS reserves the right to:

- Move a team to a league of equal competitiveness.
- Retain a team in the league, but invalidate its record, making it ineligible for awards.
- Drop a team from the league without a refund.

In coed divisions, there must be equal or more females on the field/court.

All participants must be 18 years or older as of December 31, 2016.

To ensure safety and uniformity within our programs, we have established strict age limits for youth and adults:

- Youth: Persons 5 through 17 years
- Adult: Persons 18 years and older

In addition, an adult may only participate in sports that are designed specifically for his/her gender and/or age group.

Adult teams whose rosters include individuals under the age of 18 are utilizing "illegal" players. In the event of a roster challenge, teams with underage players or players who are not listed on the roster will forfeit said games.

Forfeit fine is \$20 **plus** the officiating fees for both teams.

Ejected players will be fined \$25 and will be suspended for two games-not to include the game from which they were ejected.

Make-up/re-scheduled games will be added to the end of the schedule.

Teams that finish at the top of their league will be recognized.

NO alcohol is allowed on City property.

Adding players to a team roster will only be considered if the request is made in writing, and only if the reason is justified. Each player added to the roster after the first game of the season will be charged \$5/player + \$9/player fee (softball only).

By registering in Adult Sports, you (and your team) hereby give your consent to being photographed by the City of Colorado Springs (PR&CS) and/or their agents. Furthermore, you consent to the use of these photographs singularly or in conjunction with photographs/video recordings for (PR&CS) marketing purposes without compensation.

OFFICIATING FEES

The officials' fees are NOT included in the team's registration fee. Each team is responsible for an officiating fee, paid in cash, prior to game time.

Basketball

DEFINITIONS OF LEVELS OF PLAY

BLUE Recreation: Teams consist of players that have solid and fundamental skills and knowledge of the game. Teams may demonstrate offensive and defensive strategies, but not on a consistent basis.

WHITE Recreation: Teams are not equally balanced with skilled players. Players have average skills and are seeking a quality level of recreational competition.

RED Recreation: Teams are not equally balanced with skilled players. Players and teams tend to be more at the beginning level who want to be active in recreation.

Flag Football

DEFINITIONS OF LEVELS OF PLAY

BLUE Recreation: Players have solid fundamental skills and knowledge. Team may use a variety of offensive and defensive formations. Individuals are competitive and work well as a team.

WHITE Recreation: Teams consist of a wide range of ages and playing experiences. Teams are not equally balanced with skilled and/or knowledgeable players. Generally one or two players excel.

RED Recreation: Teams are made-up of average skilled players. Teams are generally newly formed and consist of individuals who are average or below average in size, speed, and agility.


GENERAL RULES

- 4-on-4 is played in two twelve-minute halves.
- 8-on-8 is played in two twenty-minute halves.
- Coin flip determines which team will begin the series.
- Interceptions can be run back; the start of the offensive play is determined by the location of the downed player.
- Clock stops for team time-outs, referee time-outs, and at the last 2 minutes of the 2nd half.
- Once the ball is spotted, the team has 30 seconds to snap the ball.

Volleyball

DEFINITIONS OF LEVELS OF PLAY

BLUE Recreation: Players are highly skilled, proficient in serving, passing, setting, attacking, have solid team skills and knowledge of the game. Teams may use a variety of offensive and defensive strategies, and display strong team continuity.

WHITE Recreation: Players possess the ability, yet lack consistency, in passing, setting, and attacking. Teams may demonstrate basic formations on offensive and defensive strategies, but lack in team continuity. Generally one or two people on the team are designated as setters.

RED Recreation: Teams are made up of players with knowledge of the skills of the game, but the players do not demonstrate consistency in serving, passing, setting, attacking, or offensive or defensive strategies. Entry level teams.

Softball

DEFINITIONS OF LEVELS OF PLAY

OPEN (4 Homeruns per game) formerly referred to as USSSA

Teams sanctioned in Colorado USSSA, WSL, ASA, AFA or NSA type softball bodies. These teams typically play tournaments gaining points in the sanctioning bodies system by playing in sanctioned leagues or tournaments. These teams are typically tournament level teams that are looking to play against a similar level of competition. Many of these teams display consistent fielding and hitting skills. These are considered the highest leagues within PR&CS.

Note: Homeruns over the limit are outs.

BLUE Recreation (3 Homeruns per game)

Teams in this level are built to be competitive but enjoy the recreation aspect of the game. Some players on these teams may play in weekend tournaments. Teams display consistent offensive and defensive tactics. Teams in this division may be building to move to the upper league or in tournaments together or are a very talented and skilled recreational team. Teams consist of players with solid and fundamental skills and knowledge. Team may demonstrate offensive and defensive strategies.

Note: Homeruns over the limit are outs.

WHITE Recreation (2 Homeruns per game)

Teams in this level are built with players that have knowledge of the game and have skills of the game but are not able to consistently display those skills on a regular basis. Teams lack consistent offensive or defensive strategies and/or abilities, team is average on defense and offense. Teams in this league may be building to move up to the next level.

Note: Homeruns over the limit are outs.

RED Recreation (0 Homeruns per game)

Teams in this level are built for the recreational aspect of softball. These players lack consistent knowledge and skills of offensive and defensive tactics. Many of these teams are work teams or beginners. Teams are made up of players with knowledge of the skills, but do not demonstrate the consistency or continuity in offensive or defensive strategies or skills.

Note: Homeruns over the limit are outs.

Wooden Bat League (Unlimited Homeruns per game)

This is an open league involving players of various skill levels. The nature of this game creates a game based on defense, pitching and base hitting. This is the only league where some bats are provided, players may use their own bats. All bats must be of all wood and official softball.

UNIFORMS

We recommend that teams wear uniform t-shirts/jerseys of matching or similar color with permanent numbers on either the front or the back of the jersey.

LEAGUE INFORMATION

- Season length may vary due to the weather and the number of teams in each league.
- Softball team rosters are limited to 15 players.
- Softball player fees are due with the team roster at registration. Each player listed on the roster must pay a \$9 fee.
- In coed divisions, there must be equal or more females on the team, and at least one male from each team on the field during play.
- Spring softball includes double-headers.
- Softball Teams are responsible to keep score of their own games.
- Season begins week of March 14 and should end by May 1.

HOME RUNS AND RUN RULE

A home run is defined as any batted ball that goes over and out of the field of play in fair territory. A home run limit has been set for each level of competition, see chart below. Once the team's limit has been reached, no further home runs will be allowed.

Additional home runs will result in an out.

Open:	4 per game
Recreation (Blue):	3 per game
Recreation (White):	2 per game
Recreation (Red):	0 per game
Wooden Bat:	Unlimited

Slow-pitch Run Rule:

- one-hour time limit with a 20 run limit after 3 innings; or
- 15 run limit after 4 innings; or
- 10 run limit after 5, 6, or 7 innings; or whichever comes first.
